ESSENCE OF TONKINESE




- Moderate in type
- Neither cobby nor svelte
- Good muscular development
- Surprisingly heavy
- Should not remind one of either a Siamese or a Burmese





POINT BREAKDOWN

- Medium appears 11 times in the Tonkinese breed standard
- Medium in size but balance and proportion of greater importance
- Most points are for Color (coat + eye = 35 points)



COAT



- Medium length & close-lying
- Mask, ears, feet, and tail all densely marked
- Paw pads & point color determines base color (Natural, Champagne, Blue, Platinum)
- Range of tones light to dark
- Lighter body color in young cats, and for less contrast in older cats



HEAD



- Tip of chin lines with tip of the nose
- Nose Slight stop at eye level
- Slight convex curve to forehead
- Muzzle Modified slightly rounded wedge, blunt, as long as it is wide
- Slight whisker break
- Eyes Open almond shape
- Ears As much on the side of the head as on top, broad at the base, oval tips



TONKINESE JULY 202:

BODY



- Medium length
- Well developed muscular strength without coarseness
- Neither cobby nor svelte
- Surprisingly heavy
- Taut abdomen, well muscled, firm
- Legs fairly slim & proportionate
- Tail is tapered





TONKINESE JULY 202:

PATTERN



- Tonkinese come in 3 patterns
 - Mink Rich, even, unmarked color
 - Aqua eyes
 - Point Mask, ears, feet, and tail all densely marked
 - Blue eyes
 - Solid Very little contrast between the points and body color
 - Green to yellow green eyes





COLORS



Tonkinese come in 4 colors



PENALIZE/DISQUALIFY



Disqualify for

- Yellow eyes in mink colors
- White locket or button
- Crossed eyes
- Tail faults

Penalize for

- Extreme ranginess or cobbiness
- Definite nose break
- Round eyes

The ideal Tonkinese is intermediate in type, neither cobby nor svelte, give the impression of an alert, active cat with good muscular development which is surprisingly heavy.
