# TOYBOB iNTRo

**The Toybob cat is the smallest cat breed currently recognized.**

**The breed was discovered and primarily developed in Russia.**

**The temperament is affectionate and gentle.**

**Toybobs reach full maturity by 1.5 years, with no significant size difference between both sexes, and males can be smaller than females.**

# HEAD

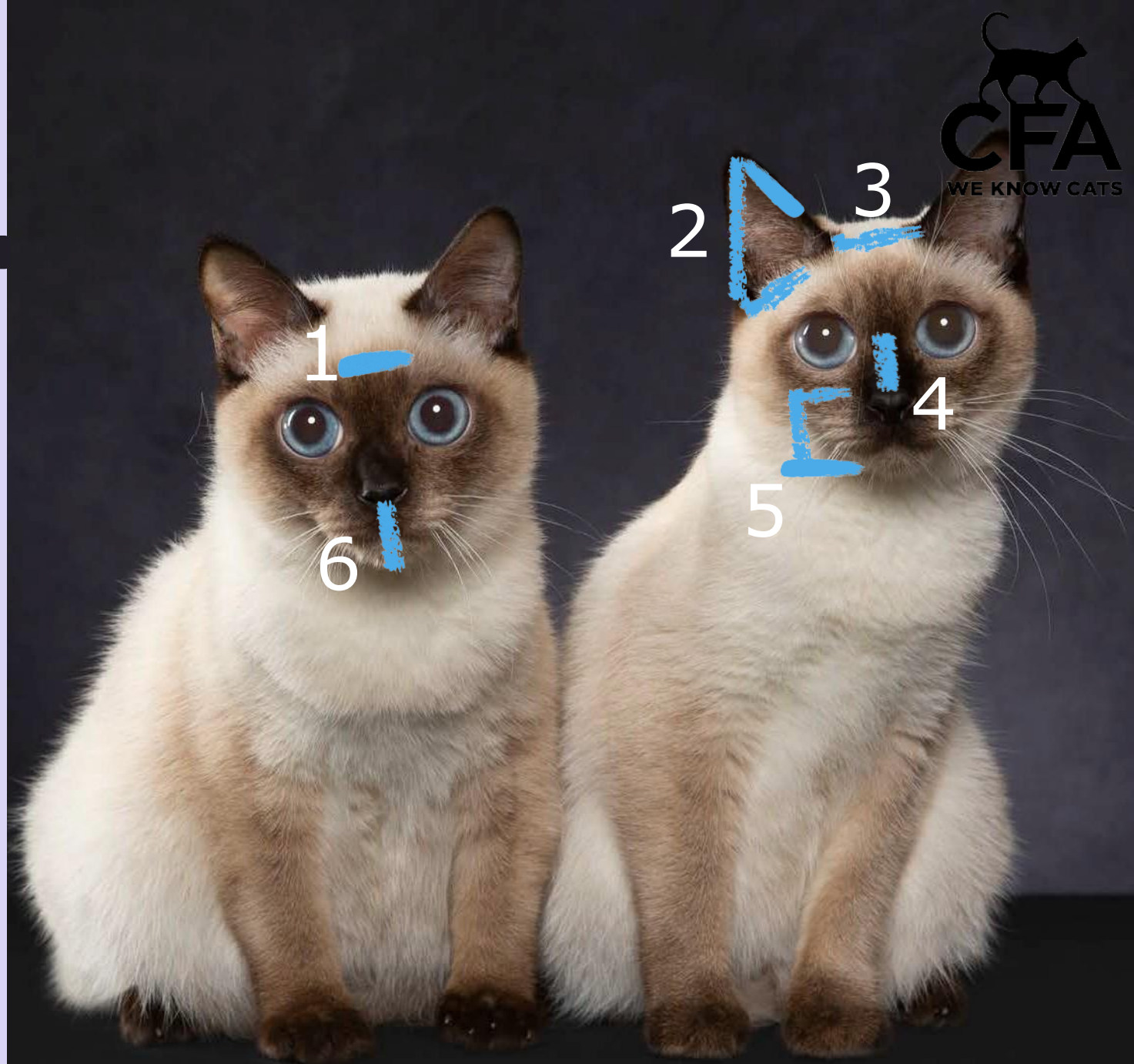
**HEAD: Medium modified wedge with rounded contours and a flat plane above the eyebrows. Jowls are prominent in adult males.**

**EYES: Large to extra large, expressive, rounded shape with a slight upward slant. All points being equal, preference should be given to the cat showing more vivid eye color.**



# + HEAD FEATURES

- 1. Flat plane above the eyebrows.**
- 2. Ears are medium, tall, and wide at the base.**
- 3. Ears are set one ear width apart.**
- 4. The nose bridge can be straight or slightly curved.**
- 5. Muzzle is short, with gentle contours following the wedge line in proportion to the face.**
- 6. The chin is strong, in line with the nose tip.**



# BODY

**The overall size is small and balanced.**

**The neck is short and thick.**

**The body is compact with a strong chest.**

**The back is almost straight when standing.**

**The legs are medium long and strong, and back legs are slightly longer.**



# TAIL

**The tail is bobbed with kinks and curves in any combination, but also may be almost straight. The tail minimum length is two vertebrae and the maximum length is down to the hock—no preference should be given to shape or length. The bone length measures the tail length and must be gently handled and unstretched.**

# CoLoR + PATteRN

**Every genetically possible color and pattern allowed.**

**Buttons, lockets, and/or small white spots allowed; not considered bi-colors.**

**Soundness of color and clarity of pattern are unimportant.**





# TOYBOB SHORTHAIR

**Shorthair coats are medium-short, soft, moderately plush, and slightly crisp to the touch, with medium density. The coat is rather resilient and not close lying to the body. Overall texture can vary with coat color.**

**Kittens can have a wooly coat.**

**Allowances for minimal seasonal changes in coat density, texture and length.**



# TOYBOB LONGHAIR + PENALTY + DQ

**The Longhair coat is softer and plushier than the short-coated variety and tends to wave on the abdomen, ruff, and britches. The topcoat is slightly longer. A heavy ruff and full tail plume is desirable—no lynx tips.**

**PENALIZE: Oversized cat, small eyes, ears too large, short tight close-lying coat.**

**DISQUALIFY: No tail or tail past the hock, Dominant Blue Eye (DBE), Evidence of hybridization, including glitter.**
